Franz Kafka was born in 1883 in Prague as the son of Jewish parents. After studying Law, Kafka became a civil servant. In 1917, Kafka suffered a haemorrhage; it was the onset of the tuberculosis that he would die from on June 3rd, 1924 – aged 41 only.
