Lasse. And that's where Mathilda Martin comes in. Together with many sisters and cousins who all look the same to Quinn, Mathilda lives right across the street. Her overly devout (and nosy!) parents make her sing in the church choir and do lots of chores in the neighbourhood. Mathilda has secretly harboured a crush on Quinn for ages, so she is only too willing to help him get around in his wheelchair when Quinn's mother asks her to help him, and to keep him company.

Quinn quickly discovers that there is more to Mathilda than he thought; and so they embark together on a journey to discover a whole new world full of magic, adventure and danger ...
